Nebraska Maintenance Academy

The AAN Nebraska Maintenance Training Academy (NMA) was created to assist the multi-family rental industry by providing a vocational training program to fill their key maintenance roles within the state of Nebraska. NMA is the only approved Intermediary program recognized by the US DOL serving the multifamily housing industry in the state. This program has been successfully implemented in the state of Maryland through the Maryland Multi-Housing Association's Service Training Academy (MMHASTA), and proven to positively impact both the students and the properties in which they were placed.

Nebraska Maintenance Academy is proud to be the only approved Intermediary Program of its kind operating in the state of Nebraska. Our curriculum and program have met all guidelines and standards of the Federal Department of Labor.

Our program is Tuition-Free, with only some minor costs to our students which are in most cases covered by WIOA funds from the NDOL. Our program administrators work closely with state-level agencies to help our students successfully complete our 12-week program and be hired on full time in a fulfilling career position.

NMA's goals are:

To offer vocational training to those most in need, including but not limited to non-college bound high school students, veterans & any individual who desires a meaningful career change.

To provide educational training, resources and certification for the Nebraska maintenance prospective and current workforce.

To immediately place those now trained individuals into careers.

To fulfill the growing need for skilled labor in the multifamily industry.

The NMA shall not discriminate against any applicant or participant on the basis of sex, race, color, ethnicity, or national origin.



Each student is put through a 12-week intensive training.

8-week classroom hands on training covering the following topics to achieve certification level:

- Electric
- HVAC
- Plumbing
- OSHA 10-hr (\$300)
- Drywall & Carpentry
- Appliance Repair
- Tile & Flooring
- EPA (\$90)
- Deescalation Training
- CPO (\$125)
- CPR/First Aid/Safety (\$200)
- Fair Housing (\$100)
- CAMT Designation at the end of year 1 (\$750)

4-week onsite paid training will cover the following:

- Turns/Make Ready
- Customer Service
- Work Orders
- Workshop Safety
- Grounds work
- Employer Expectations
