The Legislature changed the SNAP income benefits max to 165% of the federal poverty level (about \$43,000) for a household of four). This means that families that you may work with that were just over the income level may now be eligible! Call the SNAP Hotline at 855-444-5556 or share the phone number

#### **See below for EVENT info!!**

1. Has an income that is at or below 135% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines or participates in certain assistance programs, such as SNAP, Medicaid, or Lifeline;
2. Approved to receive benefits under the free and reduced-price school lunch program or the school breakfast program, including through the USDA Community Eligibility Provision in the 2019-2020 or 2020-2021 school year;
3. Received a Federal Pell Grant during the current award year;
4. Experienced a substantial loss of income due to job loss or furlough since February 29, 2020 and the household had a total income in 2020 at or below \$99,000 for single filers and \$198,000 for joint filers

Income verification includes latest tax return, two months of pay stubs, unemployment insurance, free lunch enrollment, SNAP, Federal Pell Grant, etc. You will need to register with the FCC to continue receiving your discount.

## DHHS' Public Assistance Office Changing Location

Lincoln – The Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) is relocating the Lincoln public assistance office from the Gold's Building, located at 1050 N Street, to 246 S. 14<sup>th</sup> Street, which is at the intersection of 14<sup>th</sup> and M Streets. The new office will open next week. The DHHS public assistance office

helps people with questions concerning economic assistance and Medicaid/CHIP (Children's Health Insurance Program) services.

The Lincoln office will continue to operate this week during the move with no disruption of services, with the exception of Friday afternoon, June 4, from 1 pm to 5 pm., when the office will be closed. DHHS teammates will be available at the Gold's location until that time. The phone number, 402-471-7000, will remain the same.

On Monday, June 7, at 8 a.m. the new office will be open and available to the public.
